Readiness for Canadian ELDs



The Canadian ELD Mandate as established by the Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators (CCMTA) requires that as of June 12, 2021, all carriers operating in Canada, who are currently required to use paper or electronic records of duty status, will be required to use a certified ELD. This also carries with it a third-party certification process for all electronic logging devices used in Canada. This certification is to be conducted by a CCMTA-accredited, third-party organization and bears a significant cost to the ELD provider.

Saucon is taking appropriate steps related to the Canadian ELD requirements and mandated certification process through product development, testing, and verification. In the U.S., the FMCSA ELD requirements called for self-certified ELD devices. Saucon led the way in ensuring compliance with U.S. ELD regulations by taking the extra step of a third-party certification of its ELD product. Saucon's experience with third-party certification of the Saucon ELD device gives a strong competitive advantage for the Canadian ELD certification process.

Saucon is also not new to the differences between Hours-of-Service rules in the U.S. vs. in Canada.
